TIME LIMITS FOR SPEAKERS

Movers of reports, motions and constitutional amendments will be allowed three minutes, with other speakers from the floor allowed two minutes including those planning to second.

Motions, reports and constitutional amendments can be formally seconded from the floor without a speech. To maximise participation, contributions are limited to one speech per delegate for the whole of Conference. Those wishing to speak should indicate to the chair by raising their hand whilst remaining seated. The waving of items to attract attention is not permitted and stewards will enforce this rule.
